OUR SCHOLARSHIP

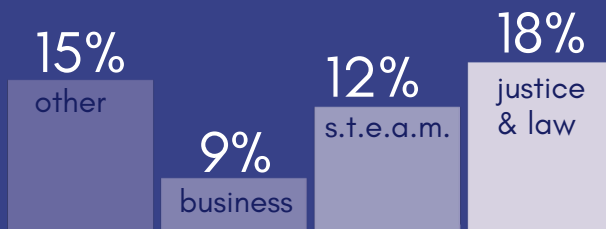
Our collegians can direct their gap funding scholarship toward tuition, housing, books, fees, and food security throughout their academic journey at all levels of education—Associate's, Bachelor's, Master's, and Technical credentials – ages 16–26.

The nsoro scholarship includes a comprehensive mentor program anchored in three tenets – emotional intelligence, financial literacy, and workforce readiness. Our executive-level coach remains in place throughout our scholars' college careers.
